## **MW #1: MARIPOSA GROVE TOUR MONDAY, APRIL 11TH | 1:45-4:45PM | \$30**

Join AEP's local plant/wetland ecologist and certified arborist Wendy Fisher of LSA Associates on a tour of the Mariposa Grove. Participants will take the Grizzly Giant Loop trail consisting of a 2-mile hike. Notable tree viewings will include the Bachelor and Three Graces, the 3,000 year-old Grizzly Giant, and the California Tunnel Tree.

## **MW #2: FIRE TOUR & PUB CRAWL TUESDAY, APRIL 12TH | 1:45-4:45PM | \$45**

Led by Steven Ward of CAL FIRE and Steve Engfer of Mariposa County, the Fire Tour and Pub Crawl will provide an opportunity to see, first-hand, the devastation wrought by the fires that are becoming ever more frequent with climate change, and the efforts made to promote resiliency and enhance recovery. This tour will start at the perimeter of the 2017 Railroad Fire near Tenaya Lodge, after which the attendees will board a guided bus tour through the areas impacted by the 1961 Harlow Fire to receive a historic perspective on recovery. The tour will also include a stop at the Stockton Creek Preserve, which will provide a panoramic view of the area affected by the 2017 Detwiler fire, as well as an overview of the 2018 Ferguson Fire. Before returning to Tenaya Lodge, the tour will make a stop in historic Downtown Mariposa, allowing attendees to enjoy a drink in some of the town's quaint watering holes.
