Local Chapter Activities

The CEQA Topic Papers within the Portal were prepared by professionals and reviewed by attorneys to provide authoritative and detailed guidance on various CEQA Topics. The Portal also includes a CEQA Case Law Database, which is searchable by CEQA topic, court of jurisdiction, or date range.
