

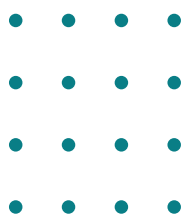

What are the implications of the CEQA litigation over UC Berkeley’s Long Range Development Plan? In 2021, a trial court judge ordered UC Berkeley to freeze student enrollment after finding the LRDP EIR to be inadequate. This brought about a flurry of news coverage, raised concerns over lost opportunities for higher education, and fueled the ongoing discussion about housing availability in California. Ultimately, lawmakers quickly stepped in to address the enrollment cap, but questions remain. During this webinar, panelists will address the litigation from a variety of angles, including a synopsis of the litigation and climate surrounding it, the legislative responses and potential downstream impacts, and CEQA practitioner takeaways.
